Grand Opening of Patriot Park 30-Acre Baseball Complex

Saratoga Springs opens the gates to its new 30-acre baseball complex, Patriot Park, on April 19, with Saratoga Springs Police and Fire hosting Camp Williams in the inaugural game.

“It will be a fun evening for the whole community as we celebrate together,” said Mayor Jim Miller. “Baseball is the great American pastime, but Patriot Park is not only a great new amenity to our City and the region, it’s our way of honoring those brave military men and women who work every day to defend the freedoms we cherish here in America.”

The evening of events will include a ribbon cutting, daytime fireworks, an inaugural game, food trucks and an array of activities, free to the public.

The new facility includes six baseball fields, eight pickle ball courts, a playground, batting cages, concession stands and a Veterans Monument, honoring each military branch.

“Patriot Park is the result of support from our residents and hard work on the part of City Council and staff to enhance the incredible quality of life in Saratoga Springs,” said Mayor Jim Miller. “This effort was five years in the making and represents more than just a baseball field—it’s a community gathering place!”

Patriot Park’s name was chosen to honor military men and women, particularly with proximity to Camp Williams. Instead of referring to the six fields as, “Field 1” or “Field 2,” each field is named after various different branches of the military.

In addition, a Veteran’s Monument sits at the center gateway of the park and provides residents the opportunity to honor loved ones who served in the military, by having their names placed on the monument through the purchase of a plaque. Name registration will take place during the grand opening. Names will be placed on the monument each year in time for Veterans Day.

“We look forward to the Grand Opening of Patriot Park and welcome everyone to come to Saratoga Springs to play ball,” said Miller.
