**Type of Item:** Award of Bid



1. **Summary:** The City, in conjunction with its engineering consultant Avenue, has designed and bid the Foothill Boulevard Extension Project from Pony Express to Lariat Boulevard. Bid documents were posted on SciQuest on February 26, 2022. Bids were opened on March 28<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 pm. 6 Bids were received with a low bid Bid of \$18,020,207.20 and a high bid of \$22,800,184.06. The low bidder was Red Pine Construction out of Lehi, Utah.
2. **Funding Sources:** County Transportation Tax funds allocated by MAG. The City's Match requirement is 6.77% which has been appropriated in fund 33-4000-725
3. **Review:** The City staff has reviewed the bids with the assistance of Avenue Engineers has determined Red Pine Construction is the lowest responsible bidder.
4. **Alternatives:** The following alternative motions are available to the Council in consideration of the proposed resolution for the award of contract:

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF  
THE FOOTHILL BOULEVARD EXTENSION PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Saratoga Springs has found it in the public's interest to obtain services from qualified contractors to provide services in accordance with the Foothill Boulevard Extension Project ("Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, the City advertised a bid document on SciQuest and in a public newspaper for the Project in order to acquire services from qualified contractors; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's engineering consultant, Avenue Consultants, provided an analysis of all quotations to determine the lowest responsible contractor; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that awarding the project to the lowest responsible contractor is in the best interest of the public, will further the public health, safety, and welfare, and will assist in the efficient administration of City government and public services.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the governing body of the City of Saratoga Springs, Utah, that the Foothill Boulevard Extension Project is awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, Red Pine Construction, in the amount of \$18,020,207.20. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
